2. Well Dressing

There are now definitely six wells, one for each decade of the Queen's reign.

2.1 Well Dressing theme per Organisation

Lyn has drawn out the following:

Swanwick Primary School	1972-1982
Swanwick School & Sports College	1992-2002
Womens Institute	1952-1962
Swanwick Hall School	2002-2012
Christians Together	1962-1972
Scouts	1982-1992

All the Wells will have 'Diamond Jubilee'
1952-1962 or whichever decade is appropriate,
so that they all look uniform.

2.2 Sites for the Wells

Siting of the wells was discussed and it was decided as follows:

- Swanwick Primary School – Old School House Garden
- Womens Institute – Baptist Church Grounds
- Swanwick Hall School – The Garden on the Green
- Swanwick School & Sports College – School Campus?
- Christians Together – Broadway
- Scouts – Methodist Church

A request was made for each well site, should have a map showing where all of the wells are sited.

2.3 Well Dressing/Equipment
