## 68.2014. 1 Public Speaking

- 1. Mark Hogg had attended the 'Have Your Say' at Somercotes, which was poorly attended, the Core Strategy consultation period runs up to 29 November.
- 2. Mark had spoken to Cllr Hayes of AVBC who said that he wished to be involved with the neighbourhood plan.
- 3. Cllr King said that AVBC's website has been updated but is quite difficult to follow.
- 4. The Clerk reported that a letter had been received from DCC regarding Mineral Extraction/Coal Gasification and Fracking operations in Swanwick area the only site is the Riddings gas well development (Planning Application CM6/1198/93), this closed in 2004/5 after a short period of operation.

### **Members Observations**

The matter of obstruction by parked cars was raised; there are problems at South Street, Broadway, The Green. DCCIIr Smith said that he would raise these with the Civil Parking Officer at DCC.

PC Anthony said that they receive many complaints all over Swanwick and they will give tickets if appropriate, the Civil Enforcement Officers to carry out 'drive bys' and issue tickets if they see cars parked unlawfully.

Report from County Councillor: Cllr Smith said that there would be footway resurfacing works at Belvedere/Butterfield Cres and they are altering the entrance to Sleetmoor Wood, to try to reduce the motorcycle access. (Somercotes Parish Council clear litter from the site regularly).

There is programmed works to the street lighting columns on Sleetmoor Lane. County Council have to make £157m cuts to the budget, and are currently working hard to identify the areas to make savings while minimising the effect on the community. DCC are currently looking to locate some staff into AVBC offices at Ripley.

If anyone has any concerns then they are free to contact him.

Mark Hogg asked about the Swanwick Hall School facilities and the charging regime. Cllr Smith would contact Kevin Gillott of DCC about this.

Cllr Smith was thanked for attending the meeting.

Cllr Peter Staton thanked everyone on behalf of Cllr Doreen Staton for the flowers and their kind wishes.

Cllr Watson informed the meeting that Cllr Steve Marshall Clarke had donated £250.00 from his community fund towards the summer activities, thanks have been sent to Cllr Marshall Clarke.
